

Interesting facts about the Al Masjid Al Haram, Mecca

The world's greatest mosque is never empty, and every sight of it is spellbinding. During the day, sunlight glimmers on the white marble floors of the Haram Mosque, and it is flooded by illuminating minarets and aesthetic lights during the night. There are numerous fascinating facts that make Al Masjid Al Haram, Mecca truly extraordinary.

These facts shed light on the unimaginable scale and significance of this holy site:

- ◆ Size: One million (1,000,000) square meters.
- ◆ Has 1800 cleaners.
- ♦ 13000 restrooms, cleaned four times / every 6 hours, daily.
- ♦ The floor is covered with 40000 carpets. The floor of the Mosque reflects away light and heat thereby enhancing heat regulation within the premises.
- ◆ Excess water from the Well of Zamzam is stored in a storage tank with a capacity of 1,700,000 (1.7 million), water bottles (10 liter capacity).
- ◆ Copies of the Quran translated into 65 different languages.
- ◆ Translation of every Friday sermon into five different languages.
- ♦ 4 million free meals for breaking fast daily, during Ramadan.
- ◆ 5,000,000 pieces of dates (seeds removed) distributed inside the mosque premises daily during Ramadan.

The iconic Al Masjid Al Haram of Mecca continues to be a symbol of unity, spirituality, and devotion.

She was the first Coordinator the Anjuman had appointed before the posts of Chair and Co-Chair were created. Arabic language classes were initiated by her in the AHI Academy for Women, Finishing school. This became the launch pad for the Academy which has since then produced amazing results.

She was instrumental in the commencing of the Islamic Weekend Program, the Al Hikmah Course which was a pioneering feat in the imparting of Islamic education in English to children from outside of Anjuman.

Her leadership continues with her present role as Co-Chair of the AHI Academy for Women. In her tenure, she has seen that the Academy received recognition from the prestigious Tamil Nadu Open University, Alhamdulillah, and also be recognised as a Community College.

Her work continues in seeking recognition for the Academy's growth and progress and in making it a globally accredited centre for women's studies, Alhamdulillah.







Boys' Home



Transitioning from one academic year to the next is always exciting. Over the summer, the new admissions took place with AHI offering admission to 81 boys. The boys were tested and then admitted into the Anjuman Schools.

During the holidays, internships were arranged for the Higher Secondary boys who expressed an interest to learn how an office or a factory functions. They were given exposure to the end-to-end cycle. Alhamdulillah, our Class XII boys did well and were admitted into interesting and much sought after courses in colleges based on their interest and aptitude – Commerce, Criminology, Business Administration, B. Tech in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning/Data Science, Paramedical Courses like Optometry, Cardiac Technology, and OT management were some of the courses that they opted for.



Meanwhile, two new wardens were appointed. The wardens were empowered through multiple trainings

and workshops like Work-Life Balance, Leadership Training, Understanding & Healing the Inner Child, Warden and Counsellor Orientation Program, etc. Officials from the District Child Protection Unit (DCPU) visited us and were well-satisfied with our facilities and functioning.



This quarter ended on an auspicious note with our senior boys fasting on the day of Arafath and a grand celebration combined with Parents Day on the day of Eid-ul-Adha.

Girls' Home



Under the able leadership of Mrs. Zubeida Asgar Ali Dhala, numerous changes were made to expand and enhance the activities of the Girls Home.

In terms of infrastructure, annual maintenance work was extensively carried out at the Girls Home. Thanks to the generous sponsorship from Oxymed Hospital - wood frames, wooden doors and many grills were provided for all 6 dormitories.

Additionally new study tables were installed in each





dormitory. To enhance safety and security, main doors of the dormitories on the first and second floors were equipped with vision panels. Furthermore, the paver blocks in the annex area were replaced with new tiles, resulting in a more aesthetically pleasing environment.



Academic Activities

An extraordinary achievement was witnessed in the academic results of our Class XII students with the top three places all secured by talented girls who achieved an impressive 97% of marks. Class X – 100% and Class XI – 99%. It is worth mentioning that Kathisha.N, a primary school student received the prestigious excellence award from Loyola Academy, for her outstanding performance at the State level talent examination. Our girls also excelled in sports with some of them being selected for State level football team.

CBSE Board Exam Results 2023

The CBSE declared the results of the Board exam for the Academic Year 22-23 on 12th May 2023. Year after year, students of Al-Hira, have been successfully acing their Board exams with flying colours. Alhamdulillah, this year too, our students have achieved 100% results in both Class XII and Class X.

In Class XII, 100 % of the students secured First class out of which 67% secured Distinctions. Zaara Yasmin with 97%, A. Shakeel Ahmed Mahdhy with 94% and A. Shireen Thaj with 92% are the school toppers in Class XII.

In Class X, 98% of the students secured First class out of which 56% secured distinctions and 2% got Second Class.

Al Yusra Omar Sheriff with 97%, Mohammed Salman Farish with 95.2 % and S H Haniya Hameed with 95% are the school toppers in Class X.

The school re-opened for the new Academic year 2023-2024, on the 12th June 2023, one week later than originally scheduled, due to the extreme heat prevailing in Tamil Nadu.

The Board exam results announced on 8th May 2023, for Class XII, is remarkable not only for the success achieved, but also for the quality of the performance of the students. With sixty percent Distinctions and thirty eight percent First Classes, the school achieved standards never before achieved in the history of Anjuman.

The top three rank holders all achieved between 96 to 97%, overall, and 98 to 99% in their core group.

The First rank holder achieved three Centums in the core subjects, a first in Anjuman schools.

Totally eight Centums were secured with three Centums in Economics, which in itself is an extraordinary achievement.

The benchmark set this year is so high, that raising the bar in the ensuing years would be some act to follow.

All students have been admitted in professional / arts & science colleges with scholarship support from AHI and many private sponsors.



A felicitation program was conducted to honour the efforts of the teachers and the students in achieving the landmark results.

It has been a historic two years 2021-2022 & 2022-2023, of outstanding Academic achievements.

The school with its stated purpose of AHI, of not denying admission to any student, whatever be their academic standard, especially in the Primary section, has huge challenges to be addressed to raise the standard of academics of such children, with additional challenges of addressing learning losses suffered all over the world as a result of the Pandemic. These issues are being addressed through intense remedial programs, conducted by our own teachers, supported by educational consultants.

The Faculty development programs are also being initiated in the course of this academic year to help the teacher in keeping abreast with modern teaching and learning tools.

Students are also engaged in co-scholastic and sporting activities taking advantage of the facilities available at AHI campus.

This academic year, new Admissions have reached a record high with the percentage of day scholars





touching more than 20% of the total school strength, while not losing sight of the fact the institution of Anjuman always prioritizes the poorest of the poor in our community.

During the course of this year, a modern new school building for boys would be ready and commence academic activities, thanks to the intense efforts of our AHI sponsor.




A workshop on "Leadership" was held on 3rd June 2023 by Human Resource Department. Principal, Coordinators and Heads of the departments participated in this workshop.

Fashion designing & Garment making Certified Diploma Students

The VTC unit continues to influence, inspire & impact the lives of our resident girls & external students. Tailoring course completion certificates were handed to 14 DACAL students of Class IX and X who passed the examination. Presently, the tailoring department houses 27 beginners sewing machines and a Fashion Maker embroidery machine. 14 resident girls of all ages were kept busy with various soft skill activities everyday during summer vacations. Lovely back packs laden with stationeries and goodies were presented to them by a friend.

The VTC has received recognition of Community College status from TNOU for Vocational Diploma courses.

A one year diploma in Fashion Designing and Garment Making for external students will begin on the 1st of August costing Rs.4700. We are immensely thankful to Allah swt for helping us achieve this long awaited



recognition for the VTC. Martial Arts, Baking, Jewellery making, Origami & Calligraphy are newly introduced activities.

Tailoring, Embroidery, First Responder, Fitness Fundas, Organic Gardening, Cooking, Crochet, Fabric Painting, Art & Craft and Palm Leaf Weaving sessions continue as usual.

AHI Academy for Women



The Academy has been granted affiliation to the Tamil Nadu Open University this term and henceforth will be known as 'The AHI Academy for Women - Community College'.

The Anjuman is proud of this achievement and is privileged to have been vested with this prestigious responsibility by none other than the Vice Chancellor himself. Decades of service in the field of imparting knowledge and working in areas of women empowerment have seen fruition, Alhamdulillah.

A Diploma Course in Psychology was especially designed to train students in the sciences of Psychology. This is a three level course.

The Ambur Project saw great response and the program is now extended to the Pernampet township. Here too, students are keen to learn and use their talents in teaching. The Bachelors in Islamic Studies program which these students hope to graduate in, ensures immediate placement in the predominantly Muslim areas of the North Arcot; bringing about improvement in the socio-economic conditions.

The AHI AW Community College has further opened vistas for many students seeking to improve their employability offering diplomas in skill development, including automation, early childhood care and education.



A state of the art Computer Lab was inaugurated by the President, Janab Mecca Rafeeque, at the first floor of the Academy premises on 12th July 2023, in compliance with syllabus requirement. The students and staff are most grateful for the unstinted support given to the Academy by the President and his entire team.



Marriage Counselling -AHI AW Community College

The Verse 21 of Surah Ar-Rum of The Holy Quran states that "And of His signs is this: He created for you wives from (the same nature) as yourselves, so that you may live in tranquility with them: and He put between you love and compassion. Here, indeed are signs for people who ponder."

It is unfortunate that today, society comprises of a large section of youth who struggle to keep a balance between responsibilities and duties, encouraging an increasing number of young couples either choosing to dissolve their marriages or simply lead separate lives. Homes are left broken when a marriage breaks and entire families face the agony of Talaq and Khula, leaving children and parents heartbroken.

The AHI Academy for Women proposes to start a Finishing School and Marriage Counselling Centre wherein young ladies from various backgrounds will be taught the sanctity of Nikah and the importance of creating healthy families; the foundation of every morally successful society.

Psychologists, Islamic Professionals, and Islamic Counsellors will conduct this program aimed at teaching young ladies the virtues of Nikah in Islam, the rights enshrined to the wife and the husband in this sacred bond.





The course will teach communication skills between partners, conflict resolution, the art of Sabr, time management, home management and the importance of caring for parents of both husband and wife, personal growth as a couple, amongst other subjects.

Health Centre

Personal hygiene was explained to the caretakers of both Homes and they were trained at the Health Centre.

De-worming tablets were given to all newly admitted students and also to other residents every six months.

Iron tablets were given weekly to the Girls Home residents above 12 years.

This year, a routine check-up for all the children returning home was undertaken on a regular basis. All those who needed specialist consultation for example eye, skin, dental were referred to the concerned specialists.

Periodic review meetings held with Units


Periodic review meetings were held with units to address and resolve key factors such as productivity, teamwork, resource allocation, compliance with policies, regulations and employee issues.

potlight - Legends of the Nation


The Girl Students Hostel is home to 58 young students from varied backgrounds, who are housed within the spacious and welcoming campus of the Anjuman-e-Himayath-e-Islam. Alumni of the Girls Home of AHI who continue to be in need of support from their Mother Home, are given priority.

The Academic year 2022-23 saw an increased demand for hostel accommodation; 61 students now occupy the facility. The AHI has made this possible by converting the reading room into 3 bedded divisions, making many changes to give safe accommodation to the growing numbers who seek a home here whilst they focus on completing their graduation.

It is heartening to note that 24 students who are Alumni of the AHI Girls Home are pursuing courses in Arts, Science and Commerce streams at the prestigious J.B.A.S. College for Women. Some studying Engineering, Architecture, Nursing and Physiotherapy in Professional Colleges are also housed here. From among the other 37 students, there are those from professional colleges like Loyola College, Madras University, W.C.C, MEASI, Preston International College and Aspire College of Excellency.

FAKHRUDDIN ALI AHMED (1905 to 1977)

Born in Delhi, Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed studied in Delhi and later in Cambridge and was called to the bar from the Inner Temple, London in 1928.

Returning to India, he practiced law in Lahore and then in Guwahati.

Beginning a long association with the Indian National



Congress in the 1930s, Ahmed was Finance Minister of Assam in the Gopinath Bordoloi ministry in 1939. He became the Advocate General of Assam in 1946, and was Finance Minister again from 1957 to 1966 under Bimala Prasad Chaliha.

During World War II when Indian National Congress party had a confrontation with the British Power, Ahmed was jailed.

He was made a national Cabinet Minister by Prime Minister Indira Gandhi in 1966 and was in charge of various ministries including Power, Irrigation, Industries and Agriculture.

He was elected President of India over Tridib Chaudhuri in the year 1974.

He held a variety of portfolios - Irrigation and Power, Education, Industrial development, and Agriculture.

Fakhruddin Ali Ahmed became India's fifth president in 1974. He died of a heart attack in February 1977.
