




Additional 2nd and 3rd Floors along with a Ramp constructed at the Dacal Building

The addition constructed to the existing DACAL building at AHI Campus includes the 2nd and 3rd floors, as well as a ramp from the ground floor to the third floor. The architect for this project was MSM Architect, while the contractors were MKMS Builders / TopLine Constructions. Each floor has an area of 6500 sq.ft, and the ramp covers an area of 4,800 sq.ft. The total area of the building, including the ramp is 17,800 sq.ft. The cost for this project was Rs. 4.5 Cr. The entire building along with the ramp was handed over on 1st September 2023.



Construction of new building with Ground +3 floors for AMHSS

The new building for a higher secondary boys school at AHI Campus has been constructed by Apporva Constructions. The architect for this project was KSM Architect. The building consists of a ground floor and three additional floors, with a total area of 38,540 sq.ft. Each floor has a typical floor area of 9,635 sq.ft, resulting in a total area of 38,540 sq.ft. The estimated cost of the project was 12 crore. The entire building was handed over on 14th September 2023.







Boys' Home



The Boys Home had a change of guard with the appointment of new Superintendent Mr. Thameen Ansari.

Meanwhile the cycle of activities continued with a renewed impetus on preparing the boys for their future. Three boys were admitted into NEET coaching. Four boys were selected for the Ullas Foundation Scholarship grooming program. The Motivation Team was formed with the mandate of inspiring higher aspiration in the boys.



Boys were taken on field trips like the Urban Climate film festival, the Arunodhaya Home for Special Children, Eco Park, and the Police Museum, to sensitize them to the world around them. A 'Science thoughts to practical' workshop stimulated scientific minds. The Boys Home Computer Lab was inaugurated with NGO Versal Go helping the senior boys hone their computer skills. NGO Bhumi volunteers helped the Primary boys with Math, while a tutor was appointed for Tamil. The Junior and Senior libraries were infused with new books and newspaper subscriptions were increased. There were screenings of important events like the launch of Chandrayaan 3, semi-final and final World Cup matches, and other world news.



The Student Rep council was nominated and fortnightly meetings held with them to better understand the needs and concerns of the boys. Recognition schemes in the form of Warden and Star Student of the Month were initiated. Monthly treats in the form of Ice Cream day and Popcorn day were introduced. Members met the guardians during Parents Days to create awareness of the Boys Home norms and activities.



The focus on Deen continues with the Quran Recitation Program and weekly bayaans for Class VI onwards and the practice of younger boys reading salah in their dorms.

Together, the Boys Home committee members, staff, and students, strive to execute the will of Allah.


We are pleased to announce that we have been ranked as follows:

It is gratifying to know that, even at the All India Level, we are ranked amongst the Top 100, at the State Level among Top 25 and at the City Level amongst the Top 20.

We are perhaps the only Budget school to be ranked amongst the Top 20 in the higher General Category. Alhamdulillah.

Education World had organized an awards function for all schools who were ranked in the Top 20 in each City. Our Convenor, B.N. Khaiser represented the school and received the award in Delhi.



ICode Global Hackathon - National Coding League

Students of Al-Hira participated in the ICode Global Hackathon 2023. It is the 7th edition of the World's largest Coding Competition in which more than 2.5 million students from 73 nationalities participated to benchmark their coding skills with peers globally. The ICode Global Hackathon is mapped to CSTA & Google CS First Coding Education Standards.

After 14 rounds of Qualifiers, two students Aditya. P and Abdul Rahim stood first in Chennai in the regional level. Ten students qualified to take up the National Level in which 5 students secured outstanding ranks and qualified for the Global Finals held in October 2023. They went on to ace the Global Finals in which they were amongst the Top 20%. of the Global Finalists. A special mention is made about Aditya. P of Class XII for having secured a highly impressive rank of 61 in the Global Finals. Alhamdulillah, this event has catapulted Al-Hira to achieve Global recognition in the field of competitive Coding.

The new building for the Boys School was officially inaugurated at an event well-attended by an august audience. The magnificent building with a constructed area of 36,000 sq.ft has state of the art facilities, ample natural light, spacious classrooms, a well-designed library, huge laboratories, fully furnished auditorium, adaptable multi-use spaces, advanced technological fittings and all essential modern features for students and staff. The impeccable design and high-quality construction is built in memory of the late parents of the main sponsor, Mr. Avais Musvee and supported by associate sponsors, Razack Family Trust, Prestige group, Dr. Zackria Sait and others.

While the new school building provides the right ambience for optimal learning, the school committee and leadership actively work towards achieving excellence in education. This academic year, the Faculty development program, was initiated with trainers, Mrs. Sukanya Sreenivas and Mrs. Jyothi Thomas. The trainers conducted a series of sessions covering various topics on pedagogy and classroom management. Teachers also participated in the online training program on Al, Python, and Robotics. The PET, Mr. Kani underwent NCC refresher training and graduated to the Third Grade Officer position.

Students are regularly enrolled in various programs to improve their soft skills. One such initiative is the Ullas Young Achiever Program organised by the CSR division of Polaris. Ten students of Class IX attended the annual workshop followed by weekly weekend classes where students from different schools participate. Our students also participated in the Codeayour Excellence Competition in Al & Coding and received a "Certificate"

of Appreciation." Many competitions such as JAM, Sudoku, Essay Writing and Math Olympiads were conducted. The students also enjoyed excursions to Queensland.

Class VII girls participate in curating utility items - boxes, purses, trays, pencil holders, baskets etc at Palm Leaf Weaving Sessions



Sports Committee




AMHSS

Al-Hira




